Rules and Guidelines

1. A band may play in more than one High School as long as at least one member goes to that school. In other words, if your band members go to different schools, you can enter to play in as many schools as you want.
2. All bands must use the back line gear provided. There will be top of the line drums, guitar amps, bass amps, and keyboards. The drums will have a double bass pedal. The only equipment the band should bring is your guitars, pedals and sticks. (AXE does NOT provide these.)
3. Each band shall have 20 minutes. These 20 minutes include time spent getting on the stage, performing, and getting off the stage.
4. EACH High School will have a maximum of 9 bands performing. These spots will be filled on a “first come, first serve” basis, so get your application forms into your Student Council ASAP! The show cannot be longer than three hours.
5. All applications must be given back to your Students’ Union at least FIVE weekdays prior to your school’s event.
6. Respect and care must be shown for all “AXE provided gear.” If you break it, you buy it!
7. No profane or socially unacceptable lyrics or behavior will be tolerated. Failure to abide by this rule will result in disqualification.
8. “AXEtreme Fest” and AXE Music have the right to use your band’s name and images in any and all promotions they wish.

How the event works...

- The order in which the bands play shall be determined by your Student Union.
- If all members of your band are not present back stage 5 minutes prior to the time assigned to you, your act will be disqualified.
- Bands with no members attending the school hosting the event will still be allowed to play at the discretion of the Student Union (as long as every band from the school itself is allowed in first).
- There will be no sound checks provided. However, the first band up may be asked to do a sound check to make sure the system is running correctly. The time involved to do this will not be considered part of their set. Don’t worry about sound quality here...remember you are dealing with AXE professionals!!!
